Limited guarantee of workmanship and materials

On the conditions noted below, RGC and Roofing Contractor together, and each of them, guarantee to repair or have repaired at their own expense, lesis in new materials only utilized in the roofing membrane or flashings of the Roof which occur during the Guarantee Period and which have caused only by:

- a) faulty workmanship of the Roofing Contractor, or
- defects of manufacturing in the materials used by the Roofing Contractor in the application of the roofing membrane of the Roof
- c) not withstanding the Guarantee Period, the guarantee for the said material is limited to the period for which the manufacturer's commitment to, and indemnification of, BGC is in effect and honoured by the manufacturer.

This Guarantee is given to and accepted by the Owner on the following conditions:

- The full extent of the liability of each of us to the Owner for or arising out of installation of the Roof is limited to this Guarantee;
- 2) Neither of us shall be liable to the 0 wner for any leaks in or repairs to any part of the Roof, in anyway resulting from any

- 3) The recommendations, restrictions, limitations, conditions and exclusions set forth on the reverse and on the attached final inspection report shall all be deemed to form part of this Guarantee;
- 4) RGC and Boofing Contractor shall have no responsibility for any consequential damage, including but not limited to loss of or interruption in any business or damage to the building or contents therein:
- 5) The Owner shall deliver to each of us personally within the Gissantee Period, notice in writing immediately that repairs are required under this Gissantee; we shall have a resisonable time to have the repairs completed, and we cannot be required to have any repairs completed outside our regular werking hours; until required repairs are completed, the Owner shall protect the Rood, all buildings affected and all contents from loss or diamage from leaks;
- 6) The liability with respect to any or cumulative claims shall be limited to an amount not exceeding the value of the contract as printed above, with the rooting contractor for the installation of the guaranteed root;
- 7) The Owner cannot require repairs to be undertaken when there are any accounts owing to the Roofing Contractor for installation of the Roof, but time shall still run under the Guarantee Period:

- The Owner cannot require repairs to be undertaken to remedy any failure or the result of any failure in proper and prudent maintenance of the Roof;
- 9) Responsibility for removal and replacement of soil and drainage mediums relating to extensive green or garden roof areas with soil depths of less than 200mm (8") for the purpose of inspection and or repair of walld leaks is provided under this Gustantee: temoval, care of and replacement of plants is the responsibility of the Owner.

Bemoval, care of and replacement of materials (eg., soil / plants / drainage mediums) relating to plantes or landscapes or intensive green roof areas with soil depths greater than 200 mm (8") that restrict access to the roof membrane for the purpose of inspection and/or repair, is the responsibility of the Owner.
