







Course to Field Reviews - IIBEC Fall Practical Seminar

The 2-day program includes an EPDM seminar and PVC/TPO seminar happening simultaneously each day (Attendees will attend both - switching seminars on alternate days). This course is intended for new roof observers and design professionals looking to gain practical knowledge on application techniques they may observe during site reviews and to get insight on how to look for issues on a roof.

8:00-12:00 Theory: Review of RPM changes and expectations with RCABC. Various manufacturers will review past experiences from the field as well as application guidelines. Experienced Roof Observers will discuss observation techniques and case studies.

12:00-1:00 Lunch provided

1:00-5:00 Practical: Review pre-installed mock-ups and take part in a deficiency scavenger hunt. Gain practical knowledge by installing materials, under supervision, on roof area mock-ups. Materials & tools provided, but P.P.E. REQUIRED (B.Y.O.)
